Since then, I have volunteered with many organizations:

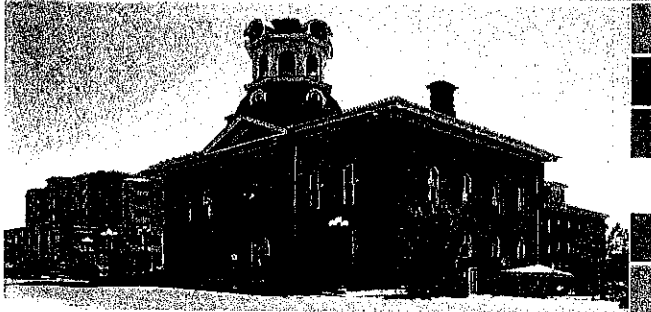
- Heart and Lung Association

## St. Lawrence Park >>>

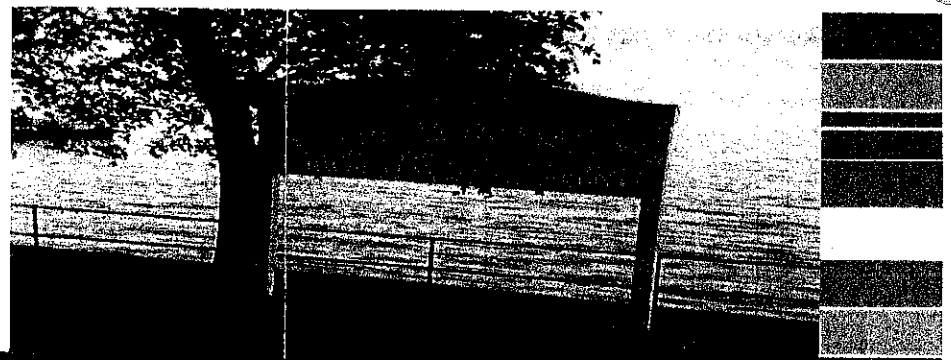
Consideration towards making part or all of the Phillip Cable Company lot to allow more visitors to park comfortably and enjoy the Park without being discouraged.
